Hi Aki,

This National Science Fiction day, SouthWind Press is interviewing John Sterling, the winner of 2012 Locus Award for Best Science Fiction Novel Rune. He is also talking about his next novel "Al_Author" coming out next month.



Tell me about your Next Novel "Al_Author" in a few lines?

Al_Athour is the story of a young **Canadian** programmer who created an Al, Zandra, who crafted a **novel**. He submitted his novel to a publisher and they accepted it, winning the **Giller prize**. Then, the truth about its authorship is revealed. And He risks losing not just his career but also his best friend.

Where did you get the idea for Al_Author?

"Al_Athour" was actually an old idea. I wrote the first draft twenty years ago. It's been redrafted over time, and when I sent it to SouthWind Press it was accepted.

What are your views on AI and the technological singularity as a whole?

Overhyped. Yes, things will change but society will not undergo a sudden transformation into utopia.

What advice would you give a new Science Fiction writer?

First and foremost, write. Don't get distracted by other things. Do what works for you, whether you're a planner or a pantser (writes by the seat of their pants), or whatever else. Discover your own writing process.

Email 4: Tuesday 10 September few days before book launch

- Book launch announcement and celebrate release day. Those who still didn't pre-order the book can jump on it now
- CTA: purchase the book

- To create early buzz for our new book and alert consumers to pay attention to it, we have a pre-order campaign 3 months before book launch and send an email a month.
- The audience for this book are male/female people between 25-55, interested in science-fiction with a literary twist, technology cyborgs, and AI. They are also the readers of Can Lit. We personalize our email based on the interests of our subscribers and also welcome them by name.
- Because our primary audience is a 9-5 business person, the best time to send emails is midweek, where they consistently check their inboxes and we have higher open and click rates. So we send them on Tuesdays. However, we also test our email for Thursday, and Wednesday to see when we receive the most traffic. And then we send individual emails based on each subscriber's action
- Because over half of our users are mobile users and half use both mobile and desktop, so we test our email both in the evening (8 pm) and late morning (10 am). We also made our emails mobile friendly.
- We choose Canada Time zone to send emails, because majority of our audience are there.
